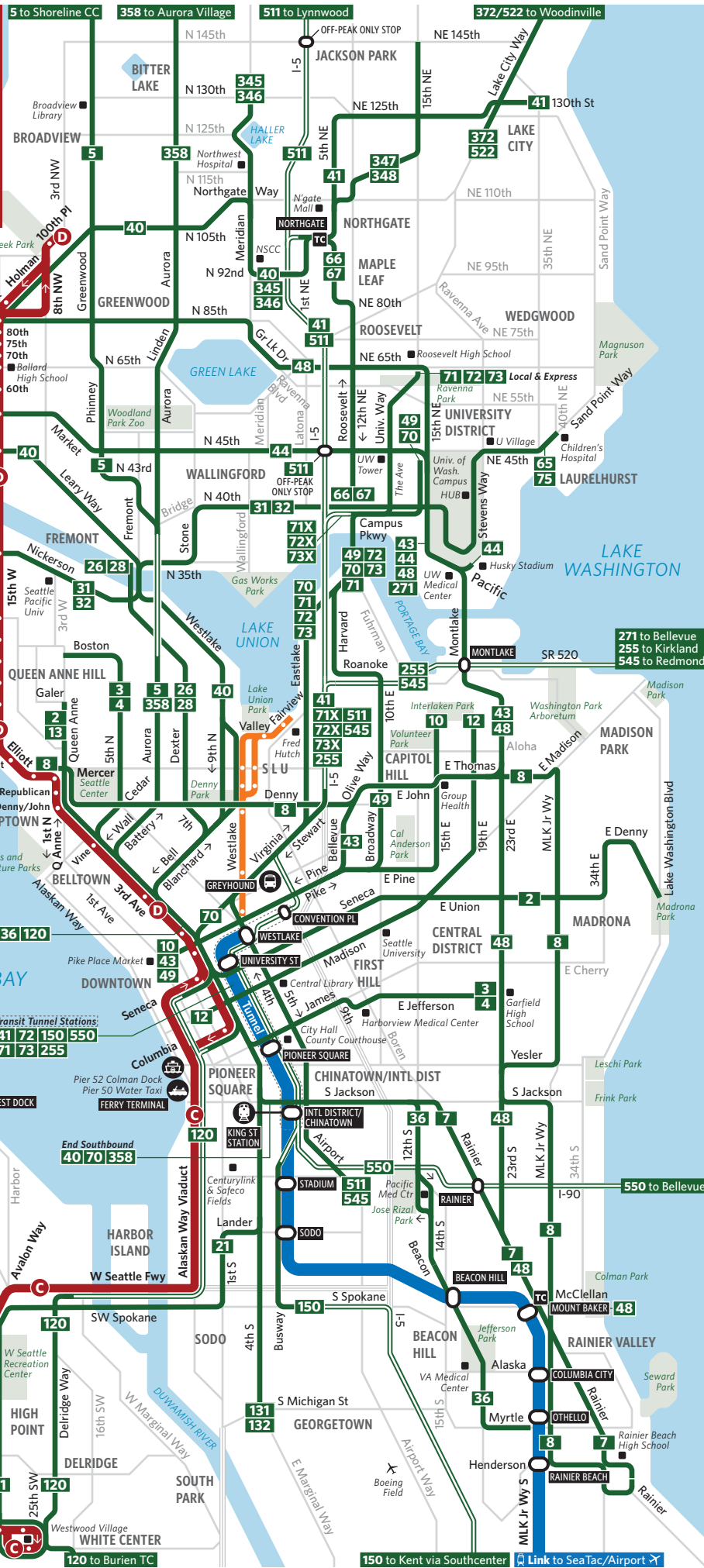


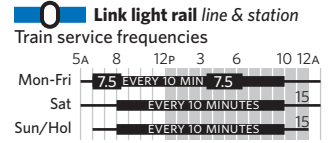
Seattle EVERY 15 MINUTES (OR LESS)

Frequent Service Guide

This diagram shows a general overview of bus and rail lines which run **every 15 minutes or less during weekdays, from 6 AM to 6 PM**. Many services also run frequently on weekends and holidays, or late into the night.
