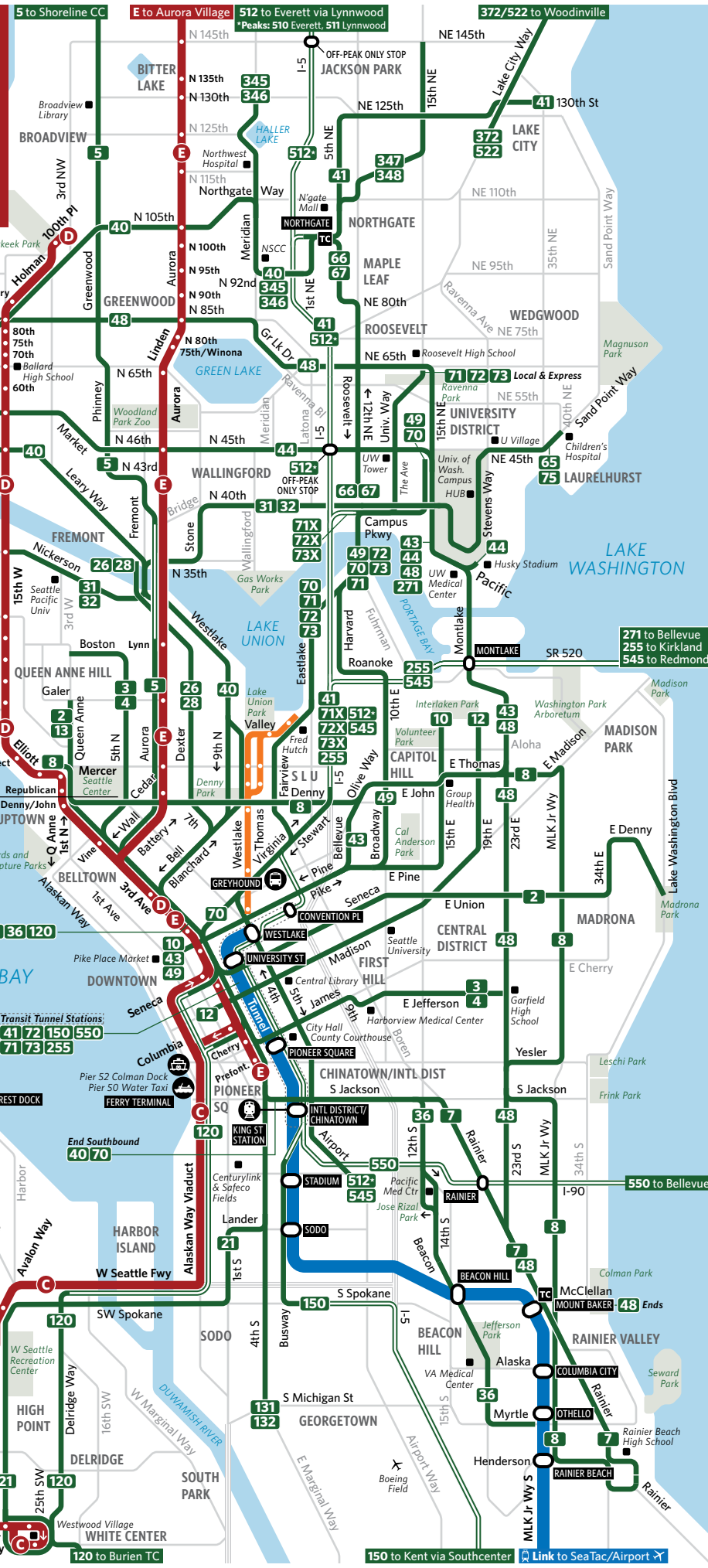
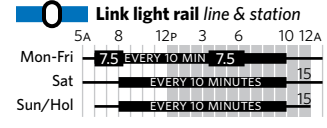


Seattle EVERY 15 MINUTES (OR LESS) Frequent Transit Network



Frequent Service Guide
 This diagram shows a general overview of bus and rail lines which run **every 15 minutes or less during weekdays, until 6 PM**. Many services also run frequently on weekends and holidays, or late into the night. Infrequent segments of routes are not shown.

C D E Lines run all day with 10-15 minute service from 6 AM to 10 PM everyday.

F makes regular stops
G limited or no stops
