

Aurora Avenue North RapidRide Improvements

The Seattle Department of Transportation (SDOT), working in collaboration with King County Metro, will soon be installing a number of **new sidewalks** and **ADA curb ramps** along Aurora Ave N and adjacent streets from Green Lake to N 145th St. The project also includes a **new pedestrian signal** at N 95th St & Aurora Ave N, as well as ORCA Metro card readers and real-time bus information signs at various locations along Aurora. Construction is scheduled to begin in early September and be completed in early 2014.

Additionally, SDOT staff will be present to discuss plans that are now under development to install **BAT (Business Access and Transit)** lanes along northbound Aurora from Winona Ave N to N 115th St (connecting with the existing northbound BAT lanes at N 115th St) and southbound Aurora from N 115th St to N 38th St. King County Metro will join SDOT staff to discuss this and other planned **RapidRide E Line improvements** along the corridor.
