Ridership Analysis

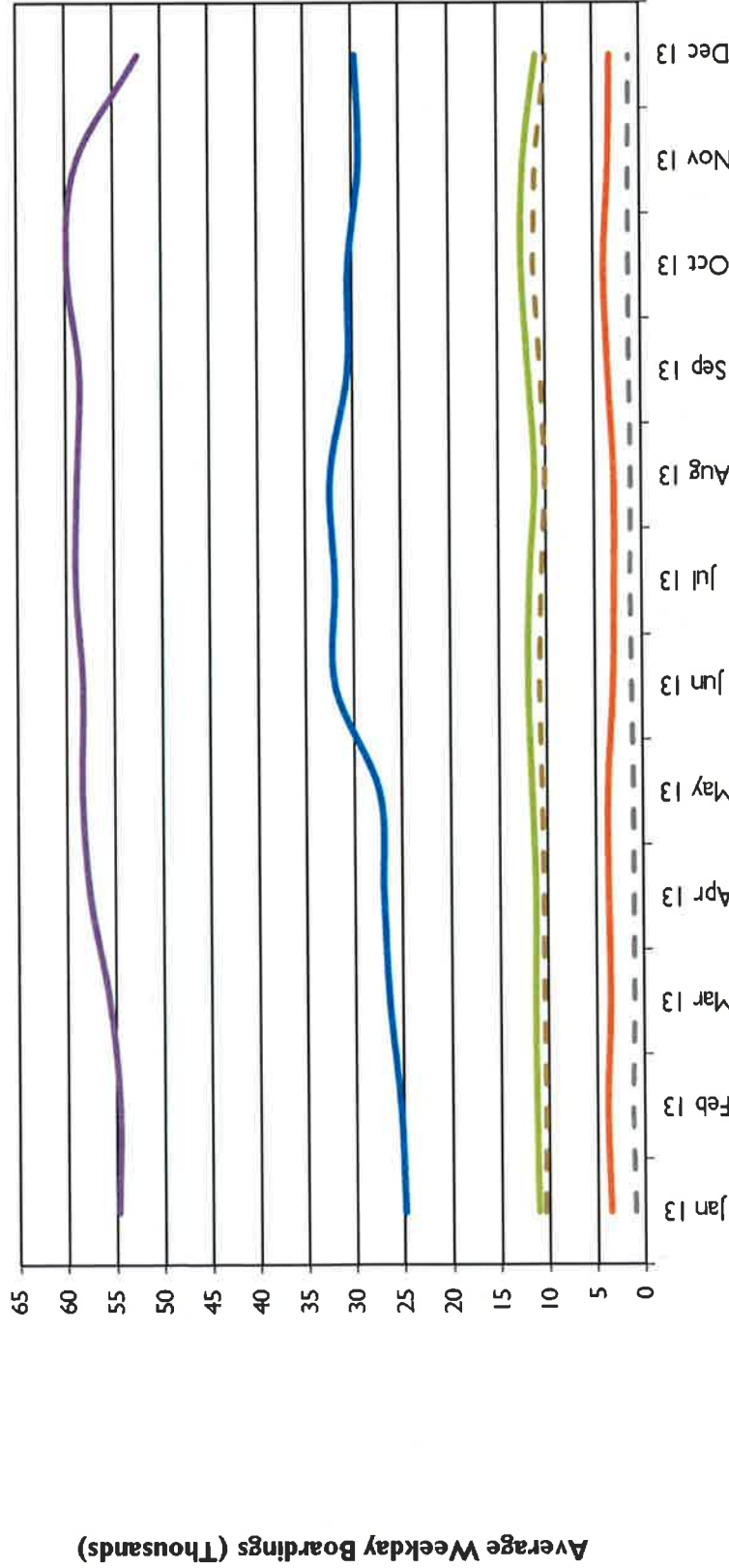
Sound Transit ridership increased by over 10% in December 2013, led by strong growth in ST Express, Sounder and Central Link boardings. Paratransit experienced a slight decline over 2013. ST Express routes in East King County, South King County and Pierce County saw the highest growth in bus ridership. Sounder boarding totals were up almost 15%. No mudslides related service disruptions occurred in December. Sounder weekday boardings were up over 14%, with a 18% increase on the North Line and an 8% increase on the South Line. Total monthly Tacoma Link boardings were flat in December, and Tacoma Link closed out 2013 with a 2% decline. Central Link had an excellent month with over 19% growth total monthly boardings and increases of 18% on weekdays, over 20% on Saturdays, and over 15% on Sundays. Finally, paratransit boardings were down 9% for the month. Systemwide, no major service disruptions occurred during December.
